2014 / 2015 Annual Rate Notices

Expressions of Interest for Short Term Lease of VIC Café

The proposed closure of the Visitor Information Centre and café in July 2014 has been deferred for 12 months to allow Council staff to undertake further investigation, planning and assessment of the potential redevelopment of the precinct.

During this period, Council is seeking appropriate input from the community and stakeholders to assist with preliminary project scoping.

Additionally Council has called for Expressions of Interest in a short-term commercial lease until 30 June 2015 for the café space as the previous long standing tenants have chosen not to extend their lease. The Stubberfields previously operated the café for a period of 23 years, operating a well respected business and Council wishes them well in their future endeavours.

Chemical Clean Out

Chemical cleanout is occurring again later this year, most likely in September – dates to be announced soon. Check the Council website or contact Council for further details.

Here is your chance to get rid of paint, and paint related products, herbicides and poisons, solvents and household cleaners, motor fuels and fluids, fire extinguishers, pool chemicals, acids and alkalis, hobby chemicals, smoke alarms, florescent tubes.

Chemical Collection will take place at Uralla Landfill and Recycling Facility. The first 20kgs or 20L are FREE!

Council Cleanup Day

Council is conducting their Annual Cleanup on 10 and 11 November 2014.

All types of waste will be accepted except for hazardous waste (such as asbestos and chemicals), paint, mattresses and tyres. All material must be able to be lifted manually.

Landfill Fees and Charges-Please Note

Fees and charges are strictly applied at Council landfill and waste transfer stations. The current structure of fees and charges has been in place for a number of years. Council staff are required to charge the scheduled fees and charges, without exception to users of the facilities. A copy of the waste fees and charges is displayed at each waste facility, on the Council website or can be obtained from the Council office.

The general rule is that there is NO CHARGE for domestic (household) general waste that has been sorted of recyclables. If waste contains recyclables and there has been no attempt by the resident to sort recyclables from their waste, then a mixed waste fee is charged.

There is NO CHARGE for separable green waste, metal waste, car batteries, electronic waste, or items suitable for sale in the Council Op-Shop.

Items such as builders waste (even from DYI home renovations), hazardous waste, commercial waste, tyres, mattresses and couches will attract a waste disposal charge.

Only residents of Uralla Shire are permitted to use the Uralla, Bundarra and Kingstown waste facilities. Residents may be asked from time to time to show proof of residency to Council staff, such as a drivers license or copy of commercial quote.

Builders Waste – it is the responsibility of the resident or business owner to prove that the material comes from Uralla Shire and does not contain ACM (asbestos containing material). If Council staff are unsure if the material contains ACM, they are required under Council Policy to treat the material as asbestos and charge an asbestos disposal fee.

Microchipping of Dogs

All dogs over 3 months of age must be microchipped and subsequently registered by 6 months of age. Council will only exempt owners from a registration fee if their dog works livestock on a daily to weekly basis. Supporting documents from an employer, landholder or contractor are required to be supplied and a statutory declaration stating that the dog is a working dog.

Please note: If false claims are made the owner will be made accountable in paying the entire dog registration fee.

Funding Available for Community Groups

Keep NSW Beautiful and the NSW Environment Protection Authority (EPA) are running a grants program to resource community groups who want to undertake a project to cut litter in their neighbourhood. The grants are used to refurbish or improve a place where litter is currently accumulating.

The Community Litter Grants award up to \$5,000 to groups who carry out a 'Local Litter Check' (following a specific methodology developed by the EPA) and use this information to come up with a plan to change the character of their litter hotspot from a public garbage can to a place community members can use and enjoy. Even if you do not want to apply for the full grant, you can acquire some funds for your group by doing the Local Litter Check alone, as all groups who carry out the Check will receive \$300 reimbursement on top of the grant.
