The NSW Rural Fire Service (NSW RFS) are reminding residents in the New England and Northern Tablelands areas that fire permits will be required from the start of the Bush Fire Danger Period which starts on the 1 August 2012.

Any person wanting to light a fire in the open in the New England area of Armidale Dumaresq, Guyra, Uralla, Walcha and the Northern Tablelands local government areas <u>MUST</u> obtain a fire permit. Permits can be obtained from local fire brigades or Fire Control Centre free of charge.
